## Community Services & Facilities Master Plan Approved

Council was presented with feedback from the Open Houses for the Draft Community Services & Facilities Master Plan by Monteith Brown Consultants. Subsequently, Council approved the revised plan. This plan, along with associated studies, will play a crucial role in prioritizing initiatives and guiding departmental budget decisions for Community Services & Facilities over the next 10 years.





# **Heavy Duty Walk-In Rescue Truck**

Council approved the purchase of a Heavy Duty Walk-In Rescue Truck for the Thorndale Fire Station.

#### In Brief

During the meeting, Council also:

- Approved severance and rezoning of surplus farm dwelling at 20887 Cherry Hill Road.
- Approved severance and rezoning of surplus farm dwelling at 21656 Heritage Road.
- Rezoned 3062 Cromarty Drive from M3 to a site-specific Extractive Industrial Zone for waste disposal.
- Rezoned 20162 Nissouri Road to a site-specific Agricultural Zone for Additional Residential Unit recognition.
- Granted relief from Zoning By-law for accessory buildings (2 sheds + garage) to exceed permitted total floor area; approved at Committee of Adjustment.
- Established an Economic Development Committee.
- Directed staff to report on potential implementation of a service delivery model for municipal payments, permitting process, and administrative procedures.
