LiveBarn Agreement Brings Live & On Demand Streams of Local Sports

Council gave staff permission to enter into an agreement with LiveBarn Inc., which would bring cameras into the FlightExec Centre, allowing LiveBarn subscribers to watch live and on-demand video of local youth and amateur sports.



LiveBarn will have exclusive rights in the FlightExec Centre for 2 years; however, the Municipality will still be authorized to televise and/or stream special events, such as when Thames Centre hosted the 2024 Ontario Tankard curling championships.

The system would be operated by volunteers, and the decision to participate in live streaming of games would be up to individual sports leagues and associations.

Alcohol Sales Approved at ORC

Council approved the sale of alcohol at concessions stands at the Outdoor Recreation Complex (ORC) on Hamilton Road.

The operator of the concession stand will still need to be licenced by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).

Should that application be successful at the AGCO, alcohol sales would be permitted at the ORC.

MLPS Ambulance to Be Based in Thorndale Fire Station

The Middlesex London Paramedic Services will temporarily be sharing space with the Thames Centre Fire Department at Fire Station #2 in Thorndale.

This will place an ambulance within Thames Centre, and may improve access to emergency medical services for the northern portion of the municipality.

MLPS will share this space while construction occurs at their Trossacks Avenue location in London.

Longer Trucks Barred from Sheils Lane Train Crossing

On June 1st there was a collision between a freight train and a tri-axle truck that was hauling fertilizer and water. This incident occurred at the Sheils Lane CN train crossing.

Although there were no serious injuries or toxic spills resulting from the collision, a safety review was conducted. As a result of the review, additional signage will be installed to bar larger vehicles from using this train crossing.
