The new ice resurfacer will be used to maintain the ice at both the North and South ice rinks.


The Olympia is made in Canada by the Resurface Corporation, which is based in Elmira, Ontario (in the Waterloo Region).

## New Community Safety Zone Coming To Catherine Street

Council received notice from the County of Middlesex that a Community Safety Zone will be established on Catherine Street in Dorchester.

Community Safety Zones are a commonly used tool to deter speeding by doubling fines near schools.

This will impact the area beside Northdale Central Public School and St. David Catholic School.

The posted speed limit on Catherine Street will remain 50 km/h.
