

REGULATIONS FOR AVON CEMETERY

1. Lots and graves shall be sold hereafter by the Secretary-Treasurer.
2. Notice of each interment to be made shall be given to the Secretary – Treasurer of the cemetery at least 24 hours previous thereto except under special circumstances.
3. No interment shall be made on Sunday except on a doctor's certificate that burial must be made within 24 hours of death in accordance with the regulations of the Ontario Ministry of Health for the control of communicable disease.
4. No body shall be moved or disinterred without the written consent of the local medical officer of health and the owner of the lot, except on an order from the court or as provided in the Regulations under the Cemeteries Act.
5. If any trees or shrubs situated in any lot shall have, in the opinion of the Board, become by means of their roots, or branches or in any other way, detrimental to the adjacent lots, or prejudicial to the general appearance of the grounds, the Board may remove such trees or shrubs, or parts thereof.
6. The erection hereafter is prohibited of borders, fences, railings, walls, and hedges in or around lots.
7. No person shall do any work upon a burial lot without the permission of the Secretary-Treasurer.
8. Monuments to be erected for or by lot owners shall be set upon adequate concrete bases, and no foundation shall be less than five feet in depth, or the full depth of the grave.
9. Children under the age of twelve years are not admitted to the grounds except in charge of an adult, who shall be responsible for their good conduct.
10. Not more than one burial shall be made in any single grave except that of the cremated remains of 2 persons.
11. Remains to be buried in a lot must be enclosed in a container, sealed securely, and of sufficient strength to permit burial with the container remaining intact.
