Council Recommends Acorn Valley Draft Plan Approval, With Conditions

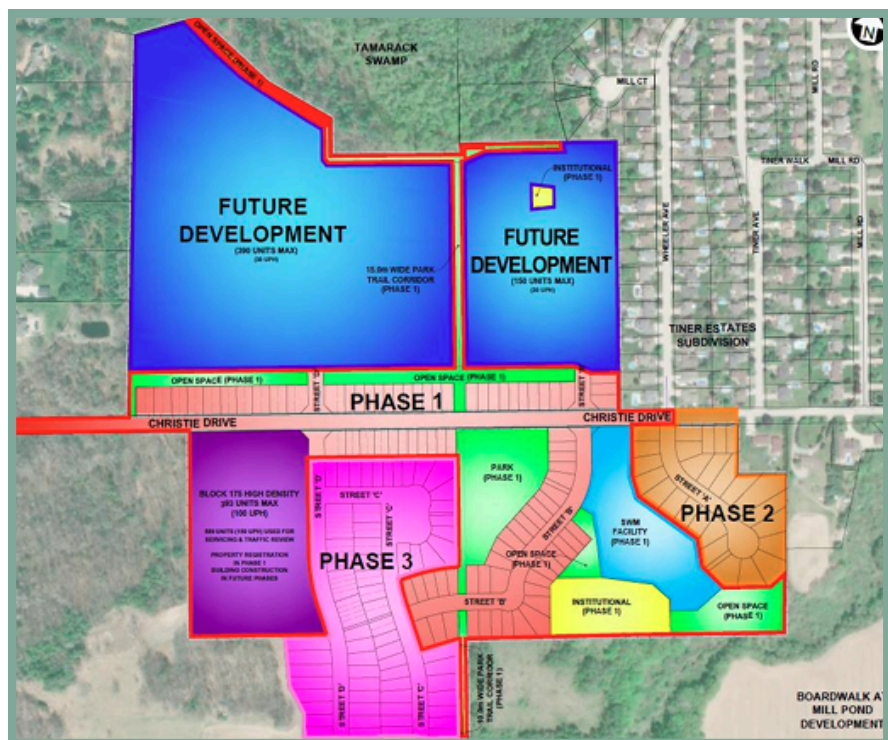
Council agreed with a staff recommendation to recommend the issuance of draft plan approval for the proposed Acorn Valley subdivision.

A resolution put forward by Councillor Heeman and seconded by Councillor Crockett amended conditions to require a road safety impact study after each phase of construction.

The Acorn Valley proposal will now be considered by the County of Middlesex.

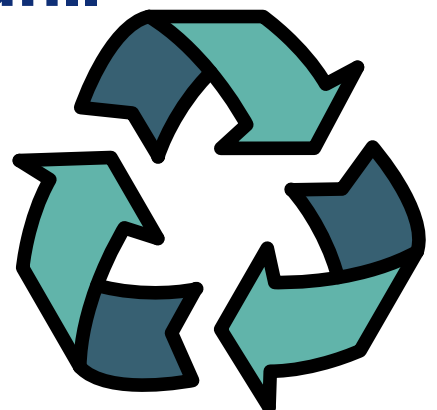


88 Tons of Oversized Waste Diverted From Landfill

Council received a report from Public Works which detailed the results of the Oversized Waste Collection program.

88 tons of waste was diverted from landfills as a part of this year's program.

Diverting waste extends the life of the landfill. It also allows for many objects, particularly wood, to be recycled and reused, rather than going to the landfill.
