Blue Box Transition

Starting January 1, 2026 municipalities will no longer be responsible for the Blue Box Program. The province will transition to producer responsibility through Circular Materials Ontario (CMO). Residents will see no changes to the regular Blue Box collection schedule.

2026 Oversized Waste Collection



The Oversized Waste Collection Program is for items that will not fit into a garbage bag. Items that will fit into a garbage bag will not be taken.

Pile #1

Oversized

A garbage bag. Items that will fit into a garbage bag will not be taken.

Permitted items are couches, chairs, mattresses, carpet, linoleum, windows, mirrors, etc. Carpet and linoleum must be cut into rolls no longer than 1.9 meters (4 ft.) in length. All glass and mirrors must be taped. Broken glass will not be collected. Water softeners and other large containers must be completely empty.



Wood and wood products must be dismantled, cut into lengths no longer than 1.2 meters (4 ft.), and neatly piled. Permitted items are fencing, picnic tables, skids, doors, desks, cabinets, etc. All large pieces of metal must be removed from the wood. All exposed nails must be flattened down or removed. Wire must be removed from fence posts.



Yard waste must be bundled and tied or bagged in paper bags. Yard waste in plastic bags will not be collected. Bundles must be no longer than 1.2 meters (4 ft.). Limbs must be no bigger than 10 cm (4 inches) in diameter. Permitted items are leaves, sticks, house and garden plants, tree trimmings, etc. No stumps or root balls will be accepted.

Items NOT Accepted in the Oversized Waste Collection Program

- Any item that will fit into a garbage bag
- · Piles that are not properly separated
- Household Special Waste
- Any recyclable material (cardboard, etc.)
- Automotive parts (truck toppers)
- Concrete, bricks, stone, or ceramic tiles

All garbage must be bagged and each bag must have a tag.





Use standard garbage bags or metal or plastic cans (minimum 30 L; maximum 125 L).

Flectronics

· Toilets & sinks

• Propane tanks

Maximum weight for bags or cans is 20 kg (44 lbs).

Set garbage at the curb by 7 a.m., but no earlier than 6 p.m. the night before. Remove emptied cans or any non-collectable waste from the curb by the end of collection day.

Dog poop and cat litter must be double-bagged, free of liquids and placed inside a larger bag.

DON'Ts X

These materials will not be collected: • Appliances & electronics • Cracked or broken toilets • Fluorescent bulbs & tubes • Renovation materials • Scrap metal (bikes, metal furniture etc.) • Tires

- DON'T place these items loose into the

garbage: sawdust, cigarette ash, vacuum dust or COVID-19 related items such as tissues, napkins, towels, gloves & masks. Bag these items and place in a large bag or container.

DON'T put broken glass or sharp metal objects in regular garbage. Place in a sealed cardboard box and clearly label "Caution Sharp"

DON'T put needles in the garbage. Place in a rigid container and contact your local pharmacy for disposal options.

Glass Bottles, Jars, Juice & Milk Cartons

- Clear or coloured food and beverage glass bottles and jars
 Milk, juice, drinking boxes or any other similar container
 Paper beverage cups (Tim Horton's, McDonald's etc) and ice cream tubs
 Spiral wound containers (Pringles cans etc)

 DO NOT recycle light bulbs of any type, no mirror or window glass, no drinking glasses, no ceramics (plates, mugs, Pyrex etc.), no broken glass.



Aluminum & Tin Cans

- All food and beverage cans and lids
 Clean aluminum foil containers
 Empty aerosol and empty paint cans
 Empty and rinse all containers, remove lids and sprayers from containers, labels are acceptable.

 DO NOT recycle aerosol or paint cans with product in them, no cooking pots or pans, no other metal items, no paper-backed foil (lids from take-out food), no foil laminates (potato chip bags), no coat hangers, no electronics.



BLUE BOX 2Paper & Fibre Products



 Newspaper and all flyers Stack them in your blue box or tie in manageable bundles DO NOT reycle plastic bags of any kind, no elastic bands.

- NOTE: Milk cartons, juice boxes, and paper beverage cups should NOT be placed into the paper blue box. They should be separated into your container blue box.
- DO NOT reycle wrapping paper, no photographs, no used tissues or paper towels.
