## **Purpose and Effect of Consent Application**

The purpose and effect of this application is to convey an approximate 12 ha (29.7 ac) portion of land from 4818 Westchester Bourne (County Road 74), to be merged on title with the abutting property to the north, known municipally as 4684 Westchester Bourne (County Road 74). The lands to be conveyed are currently in agricultural production and are within the 'Agricultural (A) Zone' of the Thames Centre Zoning By-law. No structures or change of use are proposed.

If conveyed, the retained lands, being 4818 Westchester Bourne (County Road 74), would be approximately 8.2 ha (20.3 ac) in size, and the enlarged lands, being 4684 Westchester Bourne (County Road 74), would be approximately 32.7 ha (80.8 ac) in size.

## **Description and Location of Subject Land**

The subject lands are legally described as Part of Lot 24, Concession 4, S.R.T., Municipality of Thames Centre (North Dorchester). The subject property is located on the east side of Westchester Bourne (County Road 74), just south of Crampton Drive.

## **Public Meeting**

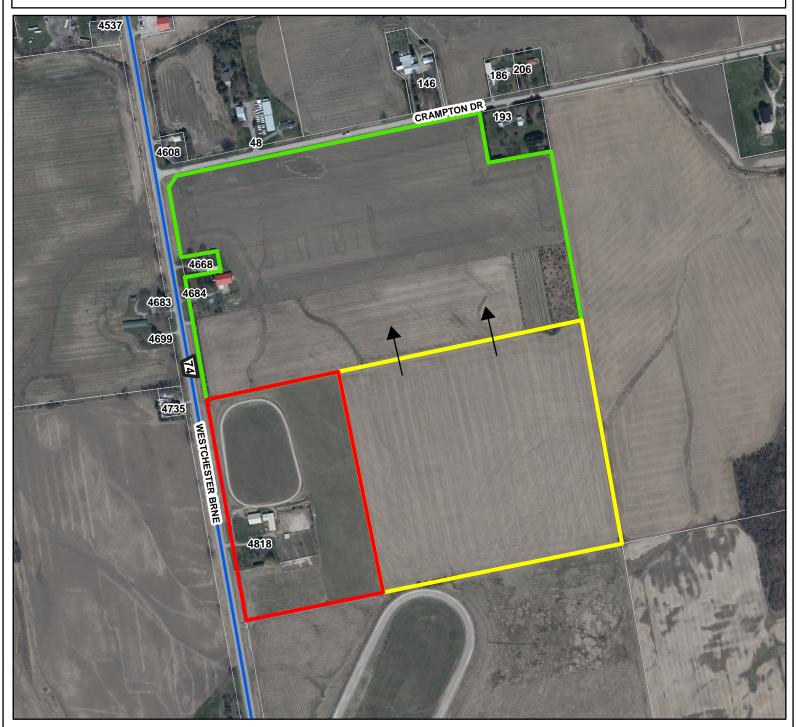
