## Policy Review Initiated

At the August 25 Council meeting, Council directed staff to initiate a review of policies and procedures.

At last night's meeting Council approved a list of high priority policies for review, specifically the ones required by Section 270 of the Municipal Act, 2001.

These include policies on:

- The sale and other disposition of land
- Hiring of employees
- Council-staff relations
- Procurement of goods and services
- Public notice
- Accountability and transparency
- Delegation of powers and duties
- Tree canopy and natural vegetation
- Pregnancy and parental leaves for members of Council

These policies are scheduled for review by the end of the year.
