Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to notify Council and the public of the yearly activity for the Building Services Division.

Background:

Under the *Ontario Building Code Act*, building departments are required to provide annual reports to Council and the public regarding fees collected and the expenses to operate the enforcement of the Building Code Act and regulations.

Comments:

In comparison to 2023, Building Services has experienced an overall 12.6% decrease in the number of permits issued. There was a 33% decrease in the number of inspections performed, a 25.4% decrease in value of construction and a 8.1% decrease in permit fee collection. Staff reviewed approximately 276 permit submissions with 235 being able to be issued during the year. 32 of the permits issued were for new residential dwellings, a decrease of 28.9% when compared to 2023.

The budgeted amount of revenue for Building Services was \$382,572.00 and the total amount of revenue collected was \$364,927.00, representing a shortfall of 4.6%.


