

2023 Oversized Waste Collection

- ✓ The curbside collection program is only for general household oversized waste.
- ✓ The three piles must be clearly separated, according to the list below.
- ✗ NO waste from farm, commercial/industrial operations or major construction.
- ✗ Waste bagged in plastic bags will NOT be picked up.
- ✗ NO sheets or pieces of drywall.
- ✗ NO boxes with small miscellaneous items.
- ✗ NO car parts.



PILE 1
Oversized Waste
Oversized items that will not fit into a garbage bag.

Acceptable items: Couches, chairs, tables, mattresses, carpet, linoleum, windows, mirrors etc. Carpet and linoleum must be cut into rolls no longer than 1.2 meters (4 ft.) in length. All glass and mirrors must be taped. Broken glass will not be picked-up. Water softeners must be completely empty of water and media.



PILE 2
Wood
Wood and wood products.

Wood items must be dismantled and bundled into lengths no longer than 1.2 meters (4 ft.). i.e. fencing, picnic tables, skids, doors, desks, cabinets, etc. No large pieces of steel attached. All exposed nails must be flattened down or removed and all wire must be removed.



PILE 3
Yard Waste
Yard waste must be bundled and tied or bagged in paper bags.

Bundles must be no longer than 1.2 meters (4 ft.). i.e. leaves, sticks, house and garden plants, tree trimmings, etc. Stumps or root balls will NOT be accepted. Limbs no bigger than 10 cm in diameter.

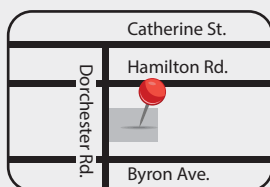
✗ Items NOT Accepted:

- tires • hazardous household waste • propane tanks • electronics
- stumps • shingles, concrete, bricks or stones • broken glass
- freon filled appliances • flower pots or trays • toilets, sinks
- any item that will fit into a garbage bag • drywall • car parts

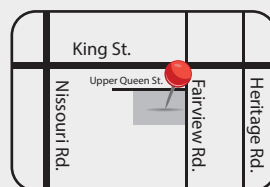
CHARITY DEPOTS – Metal, Tires, Waste Electronics
